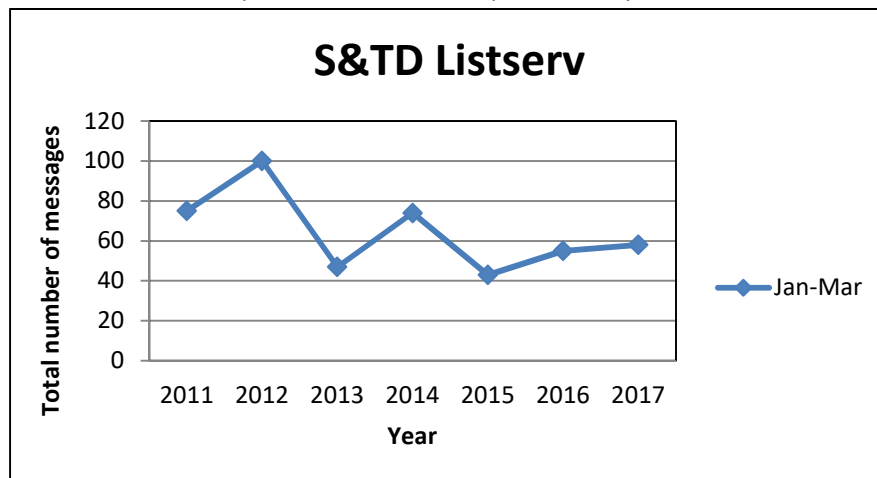


ATA Science and Technology Division

Status Report April 2017

In brief

- Our nominated Guest Speaker submitted a proposal for the upcoming Annual Conference. If accepted, Prof. Scott Montgomery of the University of Seattle will discuss translation as a historical process in science and English as the global language of science.
- We invited Natalie Soroka, an economist at the International Trade Administration, to submit an ATA58 proposal on international trade statistics, trends, and the impact of trade on the economy to help members with their business planning.
- We received and reviewed 10 presentation proposals for the science and technology track at ATA58.
- We have finished redesigning our website and migrating our blog to the new site. The new site uses WordPress and will be much easier to use and maintain.
- We continue to post to the blog, most recently about editing scientific writing.
- We were active on the Yahoo e-mail forum (165 members), Facebook group (140 members), Twitter feed (418 followers), and LinkedIn group (169 members). The average number of posts to our e-mail forum is comparable to this same period last year:



- At last count, we have 2,051 members.
